





September 4, 2025


City hosts a Neighbourhood Meeting (i.e., today).

City to host formal Committee & Council meetings to decide the applications.



Proposed Subdivision – Industrial Blocks






Proposed Subdivision – Wetland / Open Space and Wildlife Corridor Blocks






Proposed Subdivision – Roads






Proposed Subdivision – All Layers






Created Habitat, Wildlife Corridor & Limit of Development


