# **NEIGHBOURHOOD INSTITUTIONAL ZONE (I-1)**

No person shall erect, nor use any building in whole or in part, nor use any land, nor permit to use any land, in whole or in part, within an I-1 Zone for any purpose other than one or more of the following uses, or uses accessory thereto. Such erection or use shall also comply with the prescribed regulations:

#### 31.2 **PROHIBITED USES**

Notwithstanding Section 31.1, no person shall erect, nor use any building in whole or in part, nor use any land in whole or in part within an I-1 Zone for any of the following purposes even as an accessory use:

Commercial school which provides overnight accommodation or outdoor training requiring the use of vehicles or construction materials

Secondary Schools with more than 300 students
